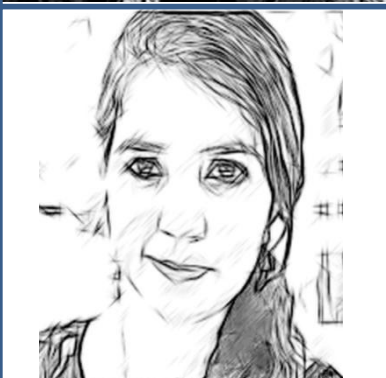
Jenny

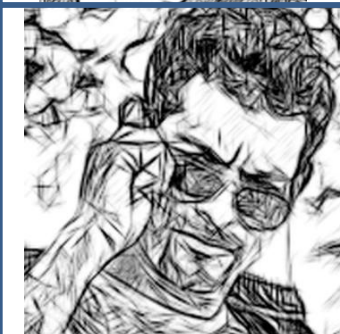
Robert
